Alexandra, a Woodstock Union High School graduate, is a screenwriter, actress, producer, and creator who grew up in Brownsville, Vermont. She began her career doing MTV commercials and entertaining audiences between takes as an on-camera NBC Page on *Late Night with Jimmy Fallon*. In Los Angeles she studied improv at The Groundlings, stand-up comedy at Pretty Funny Women, and co-created and starred in the quirky digital sketchshow @GirlslAuditionWith which premiered at HollyShorts Film Festival 2017 and on Bitpix TV.

Stephanie is an actress, screenwriter, singer, and producer who grew up in Montpelier, Vermont. She studied acting, art, and music at the University of Pennsylvania, where she graduated with a degree in Fine Arts and Political Science. Stephanie went on to study acting, screenwriting and pursue a career in film and television in New York City and later Los Angeles. She also co-wrote and starred in a film called *Aloha Also Means Goodbye* that will be premiering at the Maui Film Festival 2021. Stephanie has had Guest Starring roles on CBS's "How I Met Your Mother" and NBC's "Castle" and can be found singing and running across the country in a national Nike ad campaign "I Would Run to You".
